## Students Initiating Change

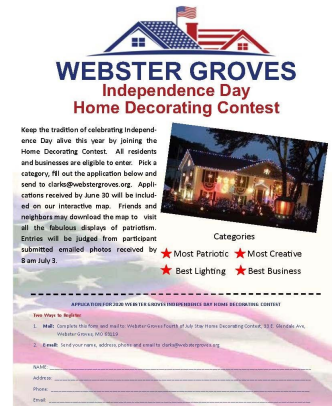
