

Some mail-in and absentee ballots for the November 3, 2020 Election require notarization. To assist voters, the City of Webster Groves is hosting another ballot notary drive to notarize completed mail-in/absentee ballots.

- Blackburn Park - 421 Edgar Rd. - Main Pavilion (Curbside notary available at this location for those with limited mobility.)
- Ivory Crockett Park - 106 Almentor - Pavilion
- Southwest Park - 1155 S. Rock Hill Rd. - Pavilion

This event is free and open to the public. Only election ballots will be notarized at this event. Please provide identification to your notary. Please wear a mask and practice safe social distancing in line and while getting your ballot notarized. Voters are asked to mail their own ballot following the event.
